GOLF BALL DROP CONTEST RULES

1.) For a donation of \$10, each participant will be entered into the "TENCO Golf Ball Drop" fundraiser scheduled for June 21, 2008. Participants may enter more than once. Participants will be assigned one numbered golf ball per \$10. A maximum of 1,000 golf balls will be sold. Winner need not be present.

2.) On June 21, 2008, at 4:00 p.m. the sold golf balls will be dropped from a crane onto the chipping range of Cedar Creek Golf Course, above a make shift golf hole. The participant whose numbered golf ball falls in or closest to the hole will receive a check in the amount \$2,500.

3.) If multiple balls go in the hole, the winners share the payout which will be divided equally among the winning participants.

4.) If no balls go into the hole, then a measurement will be held and the closest ball to the hole, measured perpendicularly from the center of the hole, will win the grand prize. Once again, in the event of a tie, the winners will split the payout equally.

5.) Winners will be announced immediately following the ball drop and need not be present to win.

PRIZES:

- TENCO is not responsible for winner's inability to claim or use the prize in accordance with the raffle guidelines.
- Prizes are non-transferable.
- TENCO will require verification of eligibility and identity before releasing prizes.

HOW TO PLAY: Conditions and Limitations:

- All entries must include a minimum of name and phone number to be eligible.
- Raffle is open to all individuals age 18 years and older as of entry date.
- Employees of TENCO are not eligible to enter.

- ODDS OF WINNING DEPEND ON THE NUMBER OF VALID ENTRIES RECEIVED.

- All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.
- Decisions by the TENCO judges on all aspects of this raffle will be final and binding.
- Winners will be notified by phone or mail. If a winner cannot be located or fails to claim prize within ten (10) days after notification, prize will be forfeited.
- TENCO assumes no responsibility for late, lost, stolen, damaged, misdirected, incomplete or illegible entries.
- By entering the raffle, winner consents, without limitation or additional compensation, to the use of their name, voice, photograph, likeness and/or entry for advertising and/or trade purposes, except where prohibited by law.
- By participating, each winner releases, discharges, indemnifies, and holds harmless TENCO, its officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all liability, loss harm, injury, damage, cost and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from the use of the prize or participation in the raffle.
- All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of individual winner and/or parent or legal guardian. Winner and/or parent or legal guardian may be required to sign an IRS form 1099 or the equivalent for all prizes valued at \$600 or greater, or for any prize as to which TENCO in its sole discretion, believes is warranted. Winner and/or parent or legal guardian will be required to execute an affidavit of eligibility, liability/money received release, and an authorization for publicity within ten (10) days of notification. In the event of noncompliance within this time period, the prize will be forfeited. Upon forfeiture, no compensation will be given.
